





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## 5 - What aspect of Prof. /Dr. Chisom Ubabukoh's approach to teaching best helped your learning?

- Reteaching what was supposed to be taught in the lecture in an understandable way.
- The tutorials are sometimes not linked with the lectures, the organization is pretty poor.
- Demonstrate and explains clearly. Makes sure everyone understands content and takes questions. Encourages discussion.
- Provided useful and simple explanation for finding solutions. Nicely explained some of the concepts, so I was able to better understand how to approach the tasks, though still not why was I approaching them.
- · Very good at explaining what we need to know
- The path is slow which is good and the teaching was very clear, the smaller class size help to clarify the doubts/unclear part from the lecture.
- It was a good thing to resolve every exercise on the board so we can see the functionning of the method.
- Tutorials were at a very good pace and Chisom always make sure we understand along the way and ask if we have any questions. I find maths tutorials hardest as I understand very little from the lectures so have to learn the majority of the course in tutorials.
- The tutorials were very helpful. Mr. Ubabukoh always tried to explain us the topic, when we were struggling with it. His explanation was clear, easy to remember and also easy to understand. His tutorials taught me more than the lectures.
- · His explanation was easy to understand
- Chisom was very adaptive to the changing requirements of him within each tutorial, he was very good at telling us how different things would be applicable to out degree programs, and would spend a few minutes at the start of each tutorial telling us the most important formulas which we would need for the exercise sheet. He would tell us which questions were the most important for us to understand, and tell us why we need to learn how to solve these problems. He would tell us which questions he was going to go through and would tell us which questions we would not be able to do (because our lecturer Dr Emre had ran out of time in lectures). Chisom also was very down to earth and approachable and would make sure to get people to participate by asking questions to the class to make sure that we understand things fully. Chisom would also encourage us and make sure that we were not feeling down if we did not understand how to do something. He would spend time creating extra questions for us to practice to ensure that we understood the content.
- · Provides clear and concise solutions in a way that is very easy to understand
- · His going over each type of question in detail to give me an understanding of a broad range of questions and topics.
- He explained the course material in detail. He showed us how to solve what we were asked to solve, and explained it comprehensively. Basically, he taught us more than Prof. Refik Emre Aytimur did.
